Camper Code of Conduct

This code is in effect from the 1st day of January 2022.

Tipi Adventure Guests,

Tipi Adventure welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and hand sanitizer, disinfectant spray for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately and your License of Occupation will be canceled immediately, and security deposit may be forfeited at the sole decision of the owners of Tipi Adventure.

If you have a fever or flu-type symptoms, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation. If circumstances warrant proof of a negative test may be required.

At this time, we will be operating under the following additional rules. These rules may change as the Province of Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

Guests: Until further notice, only household members living at the same address will be allowed to share a tipi unless they are part of your bubble or have been vaccinated. (Provincial rules apply).

Visitors: Visitors are only allowed with prior permission at the discretion of Tipi Adventure. Visitors must sign the waiver and code of conduct and submit by email before coming out.

Common Areas: In all common areas follow Provincial safety rules, wear mask if social distancing is not guaranteed, if necessary, disinfect those areas you are using, like kitchen, tables etc.

Beach, use of boat, sports fields – follow Government rules for outside gathering, if in doubt, take turns.

Playground will not be disinfected; Onus is on the camper to disinfect playground equipment if to be used.

All safety rules including social distancing apply.

Children under the age of 18: We expect that all parents will ensure their children always obey the rules. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time. Children should be always accompanied by an adult when off-site. This includes activities such as bicycling and walking.

Office/Store is open for limited hours and on request. Please wear mask when entering premise.

Respect of others: Everyone is responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore, or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance, and diversity always. We are all here to either enjoy our hard-earned leisure time, or to do our jobs as best we can: treating each other with respect is the best way to ensure that happens.
